

Faculty Senate established Ad Hoc Committee  
**Grant Implementation**  
**March 5, 2020 – April 10, 2021**

At our February 6, 2020 Faculty Senate meeting, Annie Adams and Dirk Grupe presented an open forum segment highlighting potential revenue streams for the university. One of those possibilities was in grant writing. As we discussed grants, several issues with grant implementation became evident.

Under Article Three, Section 4, of the Faculty Senate Constitution, we are given authority to form an ad hoc group: The Faculty Senate, acting alone or in consultation with other individuals or groups, may establish an ad hoc committee, commission, task force, or other similar group.

The Ad Hoc committee is encouraged to meet regularly with the appropriate Faculty Senate committees in order to create resolutions and/or policy revisions which could address and remediate grant implementation impediments. Consultation with the Faculty Senate President to determine appropriate Faculty Senate committee actions, reporting to Faculty Senate, and/or discussion with academic administrators may necessary functions of this ad hoc committee.

The Ad Hoc Committee will meet at least once Spring semester 2020 for an organizational meeting. The committee is expected to report progress on its goals of identifying impediment issues with grant implementation at the December 3, 2020 Faculty Senate meeting. The final report of the committee, outlining possible solutions to the grant implementation impediments, is expected by the April 15, 2021 Faculty Senate meeting.
