

## United States Commits A Dangerous Mistake

Lightforwar netsdare The United States is playing with dyna-mite in apporting policies of coloniation which are too atten followed by French. British and other European interests, The most serious mistake yet made by the United States in such a matter occured only recently and involved Tunisia.

and moolved Tunkija. Tunkija, like Morocco, wants more home rule under the French, Ridia and disorders in that country cauted the Prench to jail a thousand natives and areast the Tunkian premier. The French had the Bey of Tunkis name a pro-Prench exhibit. This, of course, is rather ruthless and old-style colonial disci-pline.

Thirteen Arab and Asian members of the United Nations asked the Security Council to look into the Tunislan problem. All the countries asked was for an investigation, and countries asked was for an investigation, and not a voie of censure against France. In the Security Council. Francy opposed the move. Russia favored it and dyka joined by four other desparse, including Brazil and Chile. Much pressure, brought to bear on the United States, caused this country to abstain from voting and this abstellion prevented a ma-jority voie in favor of taking up the Tuni-sian question.

Immediately, the United States was blam-Immediately, the United States was blam-ed throughout the Ariab and Avian worlds for supporting colonialism, which is an un-derstandable charge. Secretary of State Dean Acheson explained the U. S. position as one designed to let the French and Tunisia settle their own differences without interference from the United Nations. He said the two countries were already, solving the problem and that interference at this time would not be warranted.

The result, however, in the Asian and Arab worlds is to line the United States up Arab worlds is to line the United States up with old-style' colonialism, which has cost Western Europe so many friends in the last century. It is a dangerous mistake and one that the Communists will exploit to the fullest in the coming months
