The day that The Morehead News reported that authorities were investigating allegations that intefnational students were evenivestigating allegations that intefnational students were required to post cash deposits to gain admission, Bradford was asked to resign his post by Philip Conn, MSU vice president for university and regional services.

The resignation was requested for what Conn called Bradford's limproper use of his official position at MSU.


