## Dependent Parents May Receive Benefits

Dependent aged parents of a deceased son or daughter may now receive social security payments even though the deceased was survived by a widow, widower, or child. Robert A. Flynn, district manager of the Ashland social security office indicated that these additional benefits are possible as the result of recent social security amendments.

Dependent mothers and dependent fathers in this group should immediately get in touch with their social security office, Flynn said.

Before a dependent mother at age 62 or dependent father at age 65 can receive benefits they must file proof of dependency with their social security office. Generally this proof must be filed within two years after August 1958, when the law was amended, or within two years after the death of the son or daughter, whichever is later.

Flynn said that he or his office staff will be glad to discuss this or any provision of the law at the social security office located at 411 19th Street, Ashland, between the hours of 9 a. m. and 5 p. m., Monday through Friday. You may also telephone East 4-5791.

Also James Martin, Field Representative of Ashland, will be in the City Building at 10-06 a. m. (CST), and will give you information concerning social security benefits.

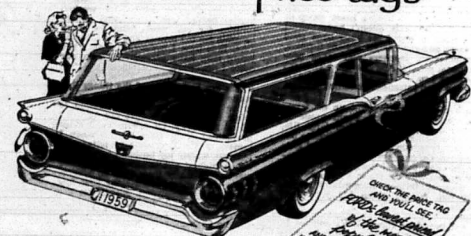

## Engineers Examination Scheduled

The state will conduct examinations June 11-12 for professional engineers applying for registration in the Commonwealth.

C. S. Crouse, secretary-treasurer of the Kentucky State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers, said the written tests will be given in Lexington and Louisville.

In Lexington, the exams will be given in the Mineral Industries Building, 120 Graham Avenue; in Louisville, at Speed Hall, University of Louisville.

Engineers in training are required to take only a one-day examination covering their field.

June 11, Crouse said. He added that engineers wishing to take the exams must file applications with the board by May 13.

The examinations are "open book" and each engineer must have his own reference and text books, Crouse said.

## Farmers Say Education Is Major Task

Rural People Think Financing Schools Is Great Difficulty

Kentucky's top farm leaders in 117 counties have listed "education" as the number one off-farm problem facing the rural people of the state.

This is only one of the surprising results of the statewide survey of facts and considered opinions of county Farm Bureau board members completed recently.

C. H. Fields, county Farm Bureau leader, said the survey of the Kentucky Farm Bureau as a part of a year-long self study of the organization.

When these top farm leaders were asked to list the most serious off-farm problems facing farmers, they listed educational problems first, with roads, taxation, public relations, size and cost of government, and labor problems following in that order.

These same leaders estimate that it now takes a statewide average of \$38,000 investment in land, buildings, equipment and livestock to earn an acceptable income from farming in Kentucky, and say that it will take nearly \$56,000 ten years from now.

Taking a look at the trend toward contract farming, most of Kentucky's farm leaders believe that it is here to stay, and that more commodities will be affected in the near future. They believe this new trend will step up specialization of production, increase the trend toward larger farm operations, and bring major changes in the marketing system for many farm commodities.

Other trends these leaders foresee for the future include more part-time farmers in Kentucky and fewer full-time farmers; and an accelerated growth of the livestock and dairy enterprises.

These are just some of the trends and factors that are being studied by county and state Farm Bureau leaders as a part of a comprehensive, year-long study of the Farm Bureau organization in Kentucky. State Farm Bureau President Burt S. St. Clair told a recent conference of county Farm Bureau presidents: "Although we are proud of our past achievements as an organization, we know that we must prepare ourselves to cope with the future needs of our members and of farm people. All of us are determined that Farm Bureau will keep abreast of the times, ready and able to meet the challenge of the future."

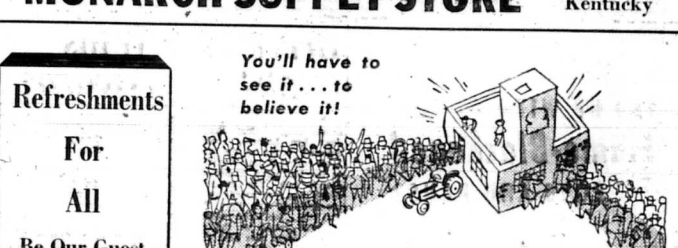

**Sale Price—\$2.30****An Alcoholic Must Be Motivated And Have Courage Not To Drink**

By J. Collis Ringo, Executive Director Kentucky Commission On Alcoholism

A study on motivation of the alcoholic for recovery, published in a recent issue of the Quarterly Journal of Alcohol Studies, emphasizes the point that to recover, the alcoholic's motivation to drink must be reversed and he must be motivated not to drink.

Organized labor recognizes this as a major problem within the rank-and-file of their membership, not as a matter of morality but of economic necessity. The set policy of one of the major unions is based on economics. Motivation through the local union is urged. The local union must pay the bill if the problem drinking member loses his job or gets laid off.

This particular union employs an educator, a field representative devoting full time to carrying this principle to the local unions. They will know that a fellow employee does not want to squeal on a friend. It must be made clear to the union membership that this motivation is to the advantage of the employee, not just the company.

Job stewards and local presidents are being educated to the fact that supervisory personnel must be able to detect the early symptoms of problem drinking and must report the guilty individual to management.

In the particular field, there is probably a better spirit of cooperation than in any phase of labor-management relations. If necessary, it is recommended that the employee be sent to a psychologist on another reason, let the psychologist convince the man that drinking is the basic trouble. If hospitalization is required, the union pays the bill from welfare funds.

In this connection, a significant analysis of health and welfare expenditures was made. For one year the total cost of health and welfare services of this union for abstainers and normal drinkers was \$37,000. Cost of the same services was \$108,000 for members with alcoholic involvements.

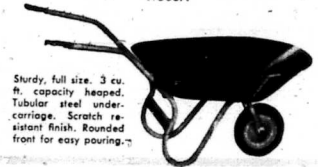

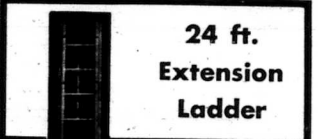

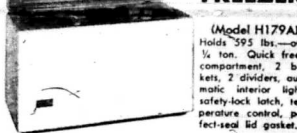
