

1 INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS COMMITTEE

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3 **Revision Date:** Standing Committee, last revision February 8, 2008, April 18,  
4 2019, June 2023.

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6 **Purpose:** To serve as an advisory board on matters pertaining to University  
7 Intercollegiate Athletics.

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9 **Membership:** Membership on the committee shall conform to regulations set  
10 forth by NCAA Guidelines which specify that a majority of voting members must  
11 be faculty and/or administrators with faculty rank. Voting members shall consist  
12 of four faculty (one per college) selected by the Faculty Senate (inclusion of  
13 protected class when possible with at least 50 percent female), two students  
14 selected by the Student Government Association (one male, one female, one of  
15 whom is President of the Student-Athlete Advisory Council), one staff member  
16 selected by the Staff Congress, an administrator with academic rank from  
17 Academic Affairs as appointed by the Provost and a staff member or  
18 administrator appointed by the President. The Faculty Athletics Representative,  
19 Director of Athletics, Senior Woman Administrator from athletics, Vice President  
20 for University Advancement, and Vice President for Student Affairs or his/her  
21 designee, shall serve as nonvoting ex officio members. Term of service for faculty  
22 and staff members shall be three years with at least one of the members (exclusive  
23 of the Faculty Athletic Representative) being replaced each year. The term of  
24 service for students shall be one year. Members may serve no more than two  
25 terms in sequence.

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27 **Duties & Responsibilities:**

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- 29 • To advise the President and make recommendations on policies and  
30 procedures related to the following:
  - 31 • Review of the implementation of University policies established on  
32 intercollegiate athletics.
  - 33 • Change in NCAA divisional status.
  - 34 • Determination of conference participation.
  - 35 • Addition or discontinuance of intercollegiate sports.
  - 36 • Facility needs for intercollegiate athletics.
  - 37 • Selection of the Director of Athletics and full time head intercollegiate  
38 coaches.
  - 39 • Practices in intercollegiate athletics which directly affect the academic  
40 progress of student athletics.
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42 **Officers:** A Chair and Chair-elect selected by the committee from the voting  
43 members; The Chair-elect shall be selected from eligible members who are in the  
44 first or second year of their term, will preside in the absence of the Chair, and will  
45 become Chair in the academic year following selection as Chair-elect; a Secretary  
46 to be selected by the committee from the entire membership.

47 **Frequency of Meetings:** At least ~~twice~~ once a semester.

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49 **Reporting Channels:** Recommendatory to the President. Recommended changes  
50 in policies and procedures shall be reported to the Faculty Senate and Staff  
51 Congress.

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53 **Minutes & Proposals Copied to:** All minutes and proposals be sent to the  
54 Faculty Senate ADS who will forward to the university archivist.
