PREFACE

References to entries forthcoming to be published, performed, or exhibited in 2012 were excluded.

As a publication of the Research and Creative Productions Committee, this report highlights faculty/staff scholarship and recognizes individuals receiving RCP committee grants, summer fellowships, and Distinguished Awards. In addition to these internal awards, MSU faculty and staff received over \$17 million in grants and contracts from Federal, State, and other agencies in the past year to help support instruction, research, and service missions of the University. These external grant awards are listed throughout this publication under individual entries.
