Your letter, of May 12th, relative to the preliminary study of the grounds of the Morehead State Normal School, received, and I have mailed you the topographical map of the present campus. *- rec'd*

At a meeting of the Board of Regents held in Frankfort May 20th, I placed your letter before the members of the Board, and they instructed me to take options on the land mentioned in your letter, or at least ascertain the prices placed upon the same. I have done this, and find that the cost would be almost prohibitive, unless condemnation proceedings are had.

In the meantime, the Board of Regents instructed me to write you and request that you go ahead with the map which you now have, and suggest a site for the first building to be erected which will be a classroom building, and, which, no doubt, would be upon the land now owned by the State School. So, if you will do this and make provision also for the location of a Central Power and Heating Plant, we shall be ready to go ahead with the construction of buildings at an early date. I may add that the Attorney General of the State does not seem to be sure that we have a right to condemn land for an athletic field, but I am of the opinion that we can do this, if necessary.
