Historical Information: The Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps (R.O.T.C.) unit at Morehead State University was activated on January 1, 1968. All male students enrolled at the University were required to take the two-year Basic Course as a prerequisite until the fall of 1971. Presently all R.O.T.C. classes count as elective credit and cadets that receive their commission are awarded a minor in military science.

Scope and Content: Collection consists of brochures, guides, programs, newsletters and other ephemera related to the R.O.T.C. program at Morehead State University from 1968 to 1988. Collection includes photographic slides of award ceremonies.
