**Biographical / Historical Information:** Sarah Buckley of resided in Delaware County, Pennsylvanian during the middle 19<sup>th</sup> century, during which she wrote and received several letters to and from her friends and family during and after the American Civil War.

**Scope and Content:** Collection contains correspondence written and received by Sallie Buckley from her friends and family between 1862 and 1868. Included in the collection is a letter from Rock Island, Illinois where her husband, Lieutenant Ralph Buckley, was briefly stationed in 1864. Another letter in the collection mentions the Battle of Antietam, Kentucky.
