

At an adjourned meeting of the Board of Regents of the Morehead State Normal School & Teachers College, held at the home of President Payne, Morehead, Kentucky, September 18, 1929, Mrs. S. M. Bradley, Vice Chairman, Judge Allie W. Young, Mr. Glenn E. Perry and Secretary E. W. Senff were present and the following business was transacted, to-wit:

The question of salary for Harry Hudgins having heretofore been referred to President Payne, upon his recommendation said salary is now fixed at \$75.00 per month, effective with the month of October 1929.

It appearing that Professor Nickel's salary has heretofore been fixed by contract for the term of one year at \$3000.00 the reduction in said salary to \$2500.00 per annum made by the Board at its last meeting is effective at the expiration of his present contract.

President Payne then recommended that vacancies in the faculty be filled as follows:

Dale Haven, Head Music Department \$2750.00 per year
 Everett Blair, Biology, \$1800.00 per year
 Dr. Helene Evers, Foreign Language, \$2600.00 per year
 Corinth Taylor, Home Economics, \$2250.00 per year

Upon motion of Judge Young, seconded by Mr. Perry, and all members of the Board present voting Aye, said recommendations were approved.

On motion of Judge Young, seconded by Mr. Perry and all members of the Board voting Aye, Miss Avanelle Bradley is elected to conduct the bookstore and proposed post office sub-station to be installed at a salary of \$100.00 per month, beginning October 1, 1929.

On motion of Judge Young, seconded by Mr. Perry and all members of the Board present voting Aye, all employes on the grounds, such as plumbers, engineers, etc. shall be under the supervision and subject to the direction of the Superintendent of Buildings and Grounds.

On motion duly carried, President Payne is authorized and directed to purchase electric Oven EO 67 AW and Toaster at the price of \$315.00 from the Kentucky Power Company, and see to the installation of same.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned, subject to the call of the Chairman.
