

Staff Concerns – October 2015

Comment/Concern: Due to construction of the East Parking Facility, Earl Clements Lane is often congested with vehicular traffic, specifically large 'dump' trucks. During the week, it's not uncommon to see student, Physical Plant and other delivery-type (i.e., Pepsi) vehicles park on the street near the Alumni Tower bridge, in clear violation of the yellow curb. Anyone attempting to reach the Eagle Lake Apartments or Recreation and Wellness Center has to zig zag thru the obstacle course created by this situation. Would it be possible to monitor this more closely, or designate another area as a unloading or 'drop off' zone?

Action: Via e-mail, MSU Chief of Police John Merrell stated:

We will monitor more frequently. The loading/unloading for delivery trucks, etc. has always occurred. The construction had just made it worse. With construction, there will be numerous obstacles to overcome. We will have to deal with them with patience. Thanks!
